Wildwood Park Fees

- Annual Vehicle Pass is valid from date of purchase for one year.
- A person 62 or older qualifies for Senior Citizen Rates.
- A Season Camping pass purchased from January 1 to March 31 are for 35 Camping Days.
- A Season Camping pass purchased from April 1 to December 31 are for 30 Camping Days.
- Season Camping passes must be used in the calendar year in which they are purchased.
- Primitive camping means no electric, water or showers. *Group Primitive is for educational or nonprofit organized groups, and must be arranged with Wildwood Park Supervisor prior to arrival.
- Regular campsites are fitted with water, 50 amp service, picnic table, grill and fire ring.
- Camping reservations that are cancelled less than five days from arrival date will not be refunded, but can be rescheduled within six months of the original date range, but only one time. Camping reservations that are cancelled prior to five days will be refunded less 25% of the total camping cost.
- Storage fees are due prior to their current expiration, a \$20/month late fee will be charged if not kept current.
