Rules of Participation

Individuals participating in the Senior Center activities and services must be members of the Columbia County Senior Center. In order for everyone to enjoy activities and services in safety and comfort, you are asked to abide by the following rules:

1. Individuals shall not engage in any activity which is disruptive to the legitimate use of the Senior Center premises by others.
2. Individuals shall not engage in any activity that may present a danger to themselves or to others.
3. Individuals shall not
 - Gamble (in accordance with local, state, and federal laws)
 - Panhandle
 - Use inappropriate language (obscene, abusive, loud, or rude)
 - Threaten or demean other
 - Smoke on county property (Ordinance in Columbia County passed in July 2011)
4. Individuals shall not participate in any illegal activity while on the Senior Center premises.
5. Individuals shall not participate in the Senior Center activities and services while under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs or while carrying a weapon.
6. Individuals shall not abuse or steal agency or personal property or money.
7. Personal hygiene must not be offensive to others.
8. Individuals shall not seriously change/alter/move scheduled program activities or building furnishings without prior approval by the appropriate program staff.
9. Individuals must leave the premises in the same condition in which they found them.
10. Individuals shall not bring pets (except for guide dogs) into the Senior Center.

In addition, all individuals:

1. Need to be able to function on the Senior Center premises without one-on-one assistance or supervision (or must be accompanied by a responsible person who will provide the assistance or supervision, as needed).
2. Must be able to get on and off vans without assistance.
3. Must be able to walk safely and independently when on the Senior Center premises (or use a wheelchair independently) or must be accompanied by a responsible person who will provide the assistance or supervision, as needed.
4. Must understand their responsibility and be able to conform their behavior to the Rules of Participation of the Senior Center.

Failure to abide by these Rules of Participation may result in an individual being asked to leave the premises until such time as they are willing to conform to these Rules of Participation.
