



**SR 388 / Lewiston Road Widening
From I-20 to SR 232 / Columbia Road
Columbia County**

Purpose: Widen SR 388/Lewiston Road to relieve congestion, improve service along a major commuter route, and improve access at the interchange to serve a rapidly-developing area.

Description: The proposed Project consists of widening SR 388/Lewiston Road from I-20 to SR 232/Columbia Road for approximately 2.5 miles. The project is being locally administered by Columbia County and is funded through the Transportation Investment Act of 2010 (TIA). The project is located in Columbia County, beginning approximately 0.2 miles south of I-20, near Gateway Boulevard, and ending approximately 0.3 miles north of the intersection with of SR232/Columbia Road. North of Columbia Road, the state route designation ends and the roadway name changes from Lewiston Road to Hereford Farm Road. P.I. No. 0008350 will tie to two other TIA-funded projects, one each on the northern (P.I. No. 0012865) and southern (P.I. No. 0008351) termini, both of which are being administered by Columbia County as well.

The proposed typical section of SR 388/Lewiston Road will consist of widening the existing two-lane rural roadway section to a four-lane, median divided urban section with varying locations of turn lanes. Pedestrian and bicycle accommodations will be provided throughout the entire corridor, using either on-street bicycle facilities with sidewalks or a shared-use path. The existing signals within the project corridor will be modified to accommodate the proposed project. No new signals are proposed.

The existing I-20/SR 388 diamond interchange will be converted to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI). The bridge on SR 388 over I-20 will be retained in its existing width with improvements limited to barrier and fencing modifications, striping, and pedestrian accommodations for the proposed DDI operation. Ramp modifications, including turn lane additions, are anticipated to occur as part of the design, though there will not be any modifications to the tie-ins with I-20.

Environmental: Columbia County will complete Georgia Environmental Policy Act documentation to meet the requirements of the TIA program.
